	 Identifying and responding appropriately to potential threats to the safety and wellbeing of children in their care
	 Implementing policy and procedures to minimise access for child abuse offenders to become involved with their organisation and to deal appropriately with any abuse or suspicion of abuse that may occur
	Educating parents and staff about policy and procedures to ensure support and compliance
	 Ensuring the policy and procedures are reviewed and sustained to ensure the ongoing safety and wellbeing of children and staff
	Providing a supportive work environment for their staff and volunteers.
